Replacing the metal pieces that are rusted out - Kiss N’ Ride - Posters have been received - working on cases for outside -looking into waterproof picture frames? They are very expensive. We can look into other ideas if this doesn’t work. - Meet the Teacher Stations - purchased 5 new tables (one 5’ red and four 6’ white) - On-site printers Wednesday at noon until Thursday at noon - Chromebook designated for parents in the office - •the board is providing us with this - we are a pilot project - • use for cash online - Playground: - K-3 are out together and 4-8 - Linda (on parent council but not here asked - “Are all the playground updates finished.” - Kindie’s still have their same area on the tarmac and the Grade 1-3 still have their same spaces - Juniors are not able to use the basketball nets as they are on the Int. tarmac area now. They are able to use the tri-bucket nets. - It was brought up that the juniors can use the basketball nets during their DPA and when intermediates are away - The students are loving all of the new activities that are painted on the tarmac.
